## The cost

To enjoy the weekend package, you can choose one of the following **Premium ticket** options (these prices *exclude* accommodation):

- £60 – Premium concert ticket
- £125 – Premium concert ticket, plus a champagne reception in advance of the concert

## Accommodation

Accommodation at the four-star Doubletree by Hilton Cambridge Hotel per night:
