(4 February, Evensong); The Rt Hon Paul Boateng, M.P. (4 March, Evensong); Ms Catherine Shelley, former Christian lobbyist and local Councillor in Brighton (11 March, Matins).

ILLUSTRATIONS. This term's illustrations are taken from Dürer's 1512 series of engravings of the Passion. The scenes depicted bear close comparison with the same scenes as shown in the Chapel windows (some twenty years later). The illustrations are Christ's meeting with Veronica (cover); Christ before Caiaphas (January); the Flagellation (February); the Crowning with Thorns (March).
