### **Principal Business**

89. Examinations Report

The Senior Tutor presented a paper providing results and analysis for the College's undergraduates' examinations in 2024 – 2025. She emphasised that the information in front of Governing Body was not final, a result of many results being received from the University not long before this week's meetings of Council and Governing Body. The Senior Tutor will provide a more detailed analysis at Annual Congregation when further data will be available.

Governing Body congratulated the Admissions Tutor, nonetheless, on the exam results received by students who have been through the Bridging Programme.

The Senior Tutor thanked members of Governing Body for their continued commitment to teaching the College's undergraduates.

Governing Body accepted the summary report of undergraduate examination results.

90. Amendment to Ordinances – Sealing Documents (Second Reading)

At the previous Congregation Governing Body had agreed, for the first time, to amend Ordinance 0.1.2. to clarify that the authority to use the College seal to execute leases made as part of the College's investments also extends to licences relating to those leases. The First Bursar presented the proposed amendment for its second reading.

Governing Body approved, for the second time, an amendment to Ordinance 0.1.2 (as set out in the paper) to clarify that the Governing Body gives its approval for the College seal to be used to execute licences which relate to leases made as part of the College's investments.
