Governing Body was asked to consider a reduced proposal from the Gardens Committee to plant two Wild Service trees on the north side of the Kennedy infill building.

Congregation approved the planting of two Wild Service trees on the south side of the footpath past the Old Lodge, in front of the Kennedy Building.

72. Possible sale of Grantchester Meadows

Congregation was asked about the possible sale of Grantchester Meadows. While this was not supported, there was interest in leasing the land and continuing to explore the possibility of managing it for carbon offset and biodiversity net gain under forthcoming Governmental schemes.

Congregation agreed that the sale of Grantchester Meadows should not be explored further.
