## 35. Update on the Future of Interview Formats

The Admissions Tutor presented a paper and provided an update to Governing Body about the discussions underway on the future of interview format at Cambridge. Full details of the consultation already undertaken within King's on interview format were presented, including a detailed overview of the cost implications of different models as background information. Results of a survey amongst Directors of Studies were also included.

Governing Body were asked to vote whether they we follow the model as recommended by Senior Tutors' Committee (STC) at the end of May, so as to ensure a co-ordinated approach between Colleges; or whether to post-pone that vote until the Governing Body meeting in June, after which time the agreed model as recommended by STC would be known – enabling GB to then decide whether to adopt said STC recommended model, or consider an alternative model.

GB agreed to defer any decision until more information and recommendations of the STC were known.

[Post meeting note – an informal meeting of the GB will be held on 5 June 2023 followed by an Extraordinary Congregation on 8 June 2023].

# 36. Buildings Annual Report

The Domus Bursar summarised plans for major building works over the next decade 2023 – 2033. He provided an update on the nine Super Projects in the Buildings Portfolio and emphasised the increasing urgency of work required to the Gibbs' Building and Bodley's Court. He further observed that much of this work will be affected by wider College considerations on the use of the main site, and also the need to ensure suitable insulation of those buildings ahead of the College achieving carbon net zero by 2038.

The Provost remarked that this would be the current Domus Bursar's final annual report, and thanked him for his support in this area. Governing Body noted the report.
