98. Oral Reports

Annual Report

The Vice-Provost presented the Annual Report. Congregation gave its approval and thanked Jonty Carr and Cristina Travieso-Blanch for their work in preparing the report.

Principal Business

99. Abstract of Accounts and the Auditor's Report

The Accounts for the year to 30th June, 2019 together with the Auditor's Report, was presented by the First Bursar on behalf of Council.

Congregation agreed:

- (i) To accept the Accounts and Auditor's Report.
- (ii) To reappoint Peters, Elworthy and Moore as the auditors.

100. Report of the Inspectors of Accounts

The inspectors presented their report. They thanked Simon Billington and the Accounts Team for their exemplary work in preparing the accounts. The College had performed well over the past decade, increasing its expenditure on its core purposes each year despite significant increases to the depreciation charge and not using untied donations to support current expenditure.

The Inspectors also led a discussion of the risks the College faces, especially about reputation. There was agreement that ensuring that we have effective means of deciding when to accept donations and grants was vital.

101. Report of the Investment Committee

The annual report of the Investment Committee was received.

102. Report of the Director of Development

The Director of Development reported that £69.4 million had been raised through the campaign towards the target of £100 million. She and the Development Office were congratulated on this success.

103. Report on Education

The Senior Tutor presented his report. As part of the University's review of size and shape, we had been asked to confirm our planned numbers. The Senior Tutor argued that the College was an appropriate size and that we should remain with the Governing Body's targets. This would lead to 400 undergraduates, plus an additional 30 supported under the Student Access and Support initiative, and 250 graduates.

He also expressed concern about the UTO scheme operated across Colleges and the Access and Participation Plan.

104. Graduate Report

The Graduate Tutors presented their report.

105. Report on Admissions

The Admissions Tutor presented his report. Funding, through the Turing Fund and other funds, was enabling many initiatives to attract and retain applicants to be trialled. In particular, the support for offer holders had begun last year and the bridging programme before new students arrive would begin next summer.

106. Report of the Research Managers

The Research Mangers presented their report.

107. Health and Safety Report

The Domus Bursar presented the Annual Report on Health and Safety and asked Congregation to approve it and to agree the objectives set out.

Congregation approved the Annual Health and Safety Report (2019) and agree objectives for 2020.

108. King's Slavery – First Report

Professor Gareth Austin and Dr Freddy Foks presented the first report of the King's Slavery project. This had focussed on historical records of slavery. The report was welcomed and Congregation began a discussion of what we might do, particularly to counteract the current effects of slavery.

109. Visitors' Department Annual Report 2019

The Domus Bursar presented the report on the Visitors' Department. The very significant increases in income were noted.

110. Any Other Business

Congregation thanked the Provost for his leadership and wished him well in his sabbatical leave next term.
