Sermons at Sunday morning Eucharists will be preached by College clergy.

SUNDAY MORNINGS. Junior and senior, resident and non-resident members of College and their guests are welcome for sherry or soft drinks in E4 after the morning services.

ILLUSTRATIONS. The cover and inside illustrations are all taken from Rembrandt's etchings of scenes from the life and ministry of Jesus. They are: Jesus and the Woman of Samaria (cover); the child Jesus disputing in the Temple (January); Jesus preaching the coming of the Kingdom of God (February), and Jesus being questioned by his critics concerning payment of tribute to Caesar (March).
