PREACHERS AND SPEAKERS. The Provost will begin the academic year in Chapel by speaking at the 6.00 p.m. Evensong on 1 October. The College clergy will preach at the following Sunday morning communion services: 1, 15, 22, 29 October, 5 and 19 November.

VISITING PREACHERS at this term's Sunday services will be Dr Andrew Chandler, Director of the Bishop George Bell Institute, Birmingham (8 October, Matins); Professor A S McGrade, KC 1964 (5 November, Evensong); The Rt Revd Richard Holloway, formerly Bishop of Edinburgh (26 November, Sung Eucharist). The Chaplain will preach on Remembrance Sunday (12 November, Matins) and on Christmas Day.

SUNDAY MORNINGS. Junior and senior, resident and non-resident members of College and their guests are welcome for sherry or soft drinks in E4 after the morning service.

ILLUSTRATIONS. The cover and inside illustrations are taken from Albrecht Dürer's woodcuts of scenes from the 'Life of the Virgin' and from 'The Small Passion' (1500-1512). They are 'Nativity Scene' (cover); the Annunciation (September); the Visitation (October); the adoration of the shepherds (November); the adoration of the Magi (December).

SERVICES are sung by King's College Choir on Tuesdays to Sundays, and on Mondays by the College's mixed-voice choir, King's Voices. Exceptions are listed.


CAROL SERVICES
