Covid-19 Update

Principal Business

37. Spalding Hostel Refurbishment – RIBA 2

The Domus Bursar sought Governing Body's approval to proceed to RIBA Stage 3 and 4 / Detailed Planning and the submission of Listed Building Consent / Planning Approval.

Governing Body agreed:

- (a) To accept the RIBA Stage II report and to agree that future work of the Design Team should focus on an EnerPHit installation, and
- (b) To approve that this project moves to the Detailed Planning Stage/RIBA Stages 3/4 (cost £560K).

38. Buildings Annual Report

The Domus Bursar presented to Governing Body a summary of the plans for major building works over the next decade 2021 – 2030.

The report was accepted with gratitude.

39. Post Qualification Assessment

The Admissions Tutors presented a paper outlining the current proposals for change to university admissions policies across the UK and Cambridge's response to the DoE consultation. Neither proposal from the Government would achieve its aims but we need to engage with the discussion. Within the College we should discuss what we are trying to achieve educationally through admissions. That might prepare us to deal with any changes that are imposed.
