<p><u>Cambridge after Rome</u> Last autumn an archaeological dig at the site of new King's graduate accommodation at Croft Gardens revealed an extensive early medieval burial ground, shedding new light on life and death in Cambridge from the end of the Roman period.</p> <p>The findings from the burials were unusual in their extent and preservation and offer a remarkable opportunity to increase our understanding of a transformative period in history. <p><u>Women at King's - Exhibition</u> Women have been a vital part of the King's community since the sister of the first Provost was married to the Chapel Clerk of Works in the 1450's, and for hundreds of years the running of the College depended on the work of legions of women, from laundresses and nurses to bedders and kitchen staff.
