



Codicil Form

If you have already made your Will but wish to add a specific bequest to King's College Cambridge in it, you may add a Codicil. This does not alter the original content of your Will. The Codicil must be signed and witnessed in the same way as your original Will, and sent to your solicitor to be kept with your Will.
