THE UNIVERSITY SERMON will be given on 27 May by Professor Tarif Khalidi, Fellow of King's College.

FOUNDER'S OBIT will be marked with a Sung Requiem with the Ceremony of Roses and Lilies (18 May).

SUNDAY MORNINGS. Junior and senior, resident and non-resident members of College and their guests are welcome to come to H3 for sherry or soft drinks after all Sunday morning services - except on Confirmation Sunday and after the University Sermon.

ILLUSTRATIONS. This term's illustrations are of engravings by Dürer. The cover depicts Jesus' Palm Sunday entry into Jerusalem, and April the risen Lord's appearance to Mary Magdalene. The remaining pictures come from an allegory of folly: May shows wisdom giving her teaching to attentive auditors; June, the folly of neglecting self-knowledge (putting someone else's fire out while your own house is burning down); July, the folly of not learning from experience (putting to sea in a holed boat); and September, the folly of waiting upon a legacy (instead of actively attending to the tasks in hand).

SERVICES are sung by King's College Choir on Tuesdays to Sundays, and on Mondays by the College's mixed-voice choir, King's Voices. Exceptions are listed.
